The chief umpire has the right to allocate sheets for Tie-breakers and Play-off games to take into account the games previously played.

The <sup>1</sup> indicates the team with the first pre-game practice session. At the conclusion of the team's pre-game practice, one player delivers one stone to the tee at the playing end. The team with the lesser Draw Shot Distance (DSD) has the choice of delivering first or second stone in the first end.
