The first named team has the first pre-game practice session. At the conclusion of the team's pre-game practice, one player delivers one stone to the tee at the home end. The team with the better Last Stone Draw (LSD) has the choice of the placement of the stationary stones in the first end. If the LSDs are the same, a coin toss will determine which team has the choice.

Training on 18 April is for 12 minutes on each sheet, switching from A, to B, to C, to D, to E.

First named teams in each draw play the stones with the dark coloured handles, and wear dark coloured upper playing garments.
